5/25/24 Michigan Motorsports Racing Association (Waterford, MI)

6/1/24 Capitol Quarter Midget Association (Lansing, MI)

6/15/24 Northwest Ohio Quarter Midget Racing (Toledo/Maumee, OH)

COST: \$30 per car

SCHEDULE:

10:00-11:45 a.m.: Open Practice

10:30–11:30 a.m.: Sign-ins (Sign-ins after 11:30 a.m. will start at tail of their heat)

12:00 p.m.: Drivers/Handlers Meeting

**Heat Races begin immediately following handlers meeting - Rookies need to bring cars to meeting

30 minute break between Heats to Lower, and Lowers to Features

RACE FORMAT:

- All Drivers will run at least 2 races
- No warm ups for heats and lowers. A-Mains have a 30 second warm up (except Rookie Classes)
- 3 strikes will be scored as DNF and given finishing points, except in Rookie Classes. Rookie classes will continue racing even after 3+ strikes

- DQ based on flagrant call; tech or safety will be scored as DQ and receive only sign-in points
- All Nascar Youth Series rules apply, unless otherwise stated
- 5 lap work rule After a race line-up is determined and cars are in racing order, if there are cars in the work area, 5 laps will be given for cars once stopped in the work area to complete repairs and re-enter the race
- In the event that we have more than a full field in one class (max 8 cars in a heat race), we will run multiple heats and lower mains to fill the A Main feature. All cars will run at least 2 races. (Rookies no more than 8 cars, Jr. classes 10, Sr. & up 12 cars)

Finishing position and passing points from the heat races are used to determine position in the A-main and lower mains:

Finishing Position	Points Given	Passing Points
1	55	
2	52	1 car @ 1= 1 pt
3	49	2 cars @ 1 = 2 pts
4	46	3 cars @ 1 = 3 pts
5	43	4 cars @ 1 = 4 pts
6	40	5 cars @ 1 = 5 pts
7	37	6 cars @ 1 = 6 pts
8	34	7 cars @ 1 = 7 pts
9	31	8 cars @ 1 = 8 pts
10	28	9 cars @ 1 = 9 pts

- ALL RACE TEAMS are required to have (1) ADULT representative at the handlers meeting. Any race team that is not represented at that time, their driver will start at the rear of the field for their heat race
- The driver and his/her car must be present and race-ready, at the discretion of the tech director and/or safety director, at the time the driver signs in
 - Sign-ins allowed up to the start of the heat race for that specific class
- The format is subject to change at any time at the direction of the club presidents
 changes will be announced

RUNNING ORDER:

Red Rookie, Blue Rookie, Lt WF, Hvy WF, Jr. Honda, Sr. Honda, Heavy Honda, Jr. 160, Lt. 160, Heavy 160, Jr. Animal, Sr. Animal, Unrestricted Animal, Mod W/F (subject to change based on car counts)

LAP COUNT:

Heat Races: Rookie - 10 Jr. Classes - 15 Sr. Classes - 20

Lowers Races: Jr. Classes - 20 Sr. Classes - 25

Feature Races: Rookie - 20 Jr. Classes - 30 Sr. Classes - 40

RAIN-OUT:

- No racing day will be canceled prior to its scheduled start time.
- Points will be awarded for completed features. Sign in and 1st place points will be awarded for all other races not completed
- o Driver & car must be on-site, and signed-in, at the time the race is canceled to receive points for any class(es) not completed

POINTS:

- Series points will be updated after each race by the hosting track
- Points awarded for the QUAD CITY series based off the MWT points chart.

TECH:

- All classes will cross the scales after their heat race
- o At the Tech Directors discretion, any car not making weight may be required to cross the scale prior to being allowed on the track for the feature race
- All cars will cross the scales after each Lower or Feature
- Top 3 cars from each feature will go to impound
- All Rookies will have their Restrictor Plate pulled at Tech Directors discretion
- Tech director will determine which class(es) to tech after the last feature
- Tech director may tech any car at any time at his/her discretion

RACE DAY AWARDS:

 Rookie participant ribbons will be awarded to all Rookie Feature participants
 QUAD-CITY trophies given to the top 3 for each competitive class

QUAD-CITY SERIES AWARDS:

- Sign In fee must be paid for all 4 races to qualify for series awards
- Driver's best 4 finishes in a class determine series awards
- Rookie Classes Participation Award
- Overall Top 3 in each class will be presented the keys to the city awards at the last QUAD-CITY RACE at Toledo

ADDITIONAL:

 Each racetrack will uphold any discipline that has been imposed by Nascar Youth Series, MWT or any MWT club. Quad City Racing Series follows the MWT Zero Tolerance policy and subsequent Code of Conduct violation driver and handler disciplinary actions.
